Hello,

It is time again to secure and prepare your steers for the county fair August 8-11, 2018. The weigh in will again be held in two different locations. The first weigh will be held on **December 27<sup>th</sup>, 2017 from 10:00 am to 11:30 am at Wilbur Reid's place in Poplar**. The second weigh in will be held at **the Roosevelt County Fairgrounds on December 29<sup>th</sup>, 2017 from 9:00 am to 11:00 am**. Bills of sale will be available at the weigh in sites. The bills of sale needs to be completely filled out by the brand's owner with the buyer's name left blank. If you purchased an animal, you need to bring your copy of the brand inspection and fill out a separate bill of sale that will be used at the fair. Please submit the following information to Roosevelt County Extension office:

- A) Four photographs of the animal, one of which must be head on with the ear tag visible and the participant in the photo (this will be taken at the day of weigh in), two side shots (left and right - if possible try to get the brand in the picture, if branded) and one rear shot.
- B) Registration form with animal's date of birth, gender, breed and breeders information.

All photographs must be submitted to the Extension office no later than January 12<sup>th</sup>, 2018. Photographs can be emailed to either [jeffrey.chilson@montana.edu](mailto:jeffrey.chilson@montana.edu) or [roosevelt@montana.edu](mailto:roosevelt@montana.edu). If possible, registration forms should be **filled out and brought with you to the weigh in**. Also, please ensure that you, as the participant, are properly enrolled for the project in which you are entering prior to weigh in.

It is the responsibility of the 4H or FFA member to provide and participate in the care, housing, feeding and training of the animal prior to fair. On the registration form we are asking for a brief description of your plan of care for your animal. This does not need to be extensive, but please provide some data on your plan for housing, feeding (does not need to include a ration) and care of your livestock. If you have any questions please feel free to contact us at the Extension office and we will be glad to help you.
